PLASTIC:

ACCEPT

All Plastic Bottles & Containers:

Soda, Water & Other Drink Bottles Food & Household Bottles, Jars and Jugs Dairy Containers & Lids Produce, Bakery & Deli Containers

DO NOT ACCEPT

No Plastic Bags, Wrap or Film No Motor Oil Bottles No Styrofoam

GUIDELINES:

Empty and rinse all bottles and containers Remove and discard all screw caps



PAPER:

ACCEPT

Newspapers & Inserts Cardboard & Paperboard (cereal & cracker boxes) Junk Mail & Office Paper Milk, Juice & Soup Cartons Phonebooks, Books, Magazines & Catalogs

DO NOT ACCEPT

No Paper Contaminated by Food or Grease No Tissue No Gift Wrap

GUIDELINES:

Flatten and cut cardboard to no larger than 2' X 2' Place shredded paper in paper bag, secure and label



METAL AND GLASS:

ACCEPT

Aluminum Bottles & Cans Steel, Tin & Bi-metal Cans Empty Aerosol Cans Food & Beverage Glass Bottles and Jars

DO NOT ACCEPT

No Aluminum Pans or Foil No Empty Paint Cans

GUIDELINES:

Empty and rinse all bottles and containers Remove and discard all screw caps
